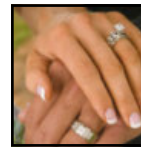

## THIS WEEKEND'S GOSPEL MEDITATION

Luke 13:22-30

Once I was invited to a group meeting with Pope Francis. Entering the room, I paused, eyeing the seats next to the Pope's fancy chair. Someone saw my paralysis and invited me to sit in the seat farthest from what I wanted. Hiding my disappointment, I sat. We waited. To our surprise, an aid pointed out that those seats were still empty and invited me and another to have them. We calmly but gleefully strode across the room and sat. Pope Francis entered, and we enjoyed two hours of amazingly uplifting conversation.

Jesus says this week to us: "When you are invited, go and take the lowest place so that when the host comes to you he may say, 'My friend, move up to a higher position.' Then you will enjoy the esteem of your companions at the table" (Luke 14:10). This is not about how to score free seat upgrades. Rather, it is a wise pattern for the whole of life. It is how to live free from the anxiety of constantly grasping for status and recognition.

Jesus perfectly embodies his seat-taking advice. He eschews his glorious throne for the lowest: death on a cross, that lonely chair we all deserve. In his resurrection, he calls us up higher to his marvelous banquet seats. This week, perhaps we should look for opportunities to choose the lowest seat. We'll be pleasantly surprised when we do.

## MEET. KNOW. LOVE. SERVE.

In a podcast we recently listened to, Dr. Mary Healy commented on the oft repeated mantra of 'What Would Jesus Do? (WWJD?)'. She contended that this is not the question which the Catholic faithful should be asking. Rather Dr. Healy rephrased that mantra as 'What is Jesus asking of me right now?' so as to lead listeners to a paradigm shift and contemplate how we, as individual members of the Mystical Body of Christ, are being called to be loving servants, obedient to Jesus our Head.

As a married couple, the verse from Ecclesiastes 4:12b 'A threefold cord is not quickly broken' (Revised Standard Version Catholic Edition RSVCE) led us to considering volunteering for some ministries (such as Adult Choir, Handbell Choir and Small Groups) together. (And yes, we have intentionally included the tabernacle of Jesus in the center of our photograph!)

We encourage all to simply trust in the words of 1 Peter 4:10 'As each one has received a gift, use it to serve one another as good stewards of God's varied grace' (Revised Standard Version Catholic Edition RSVCE), to believe that you have something to offer, that others value what you have to offer and that your presence is wanted in this family we call St. Charles.



We learned early on that the first practical thing to do was to simply 'show up' for some of the events, activities and opportunities that are so well publicized in the bulletins and on the parish's website and to talk with people. Participating in the Sacraments and meeting the wonderful people already engaged in ministries helped us to 'Meet Christ', 'Know Christ', 'Love Christ' and, happily, to provide us with avenues to apply our gifts, although imperfectly, to 'Serve Christ.'

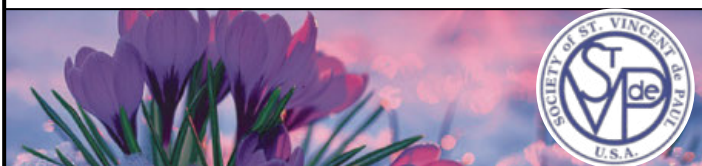

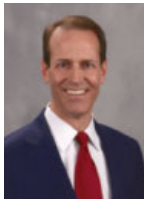
