Principal Update - Dan G.

- 360 confirmed students are enrolled for the 2024-2025 school year! An additional 11 applications are currently "in process" bringing the grand total to 370 students
 - o 346 students currently enrolled this school year
- 2024-2025 school calendar was released the 2nd week in March. What's new is St. Charles will be aligning with Arrowhead School District for Spring Break
- Library check in/out is going great minus the instructional piece. Thank you to our volunteers!
- 2024-2025 New Changes:
 - o Parent Conferences November 4th (night offering) & 5th (all day) due to Election
- Reconciliation offerings for students 10am-11am first Wednesday of the month. St. Charles parents will have the opportunity for Reconciliation the same week on Thursdays
 - 8 students attended in February and 30 students attended in March

Financials - Kristen J.

- Budget is in the final stages with the Parish Council
- Fall Fest contributions for HSA have not been deposited with total amount TBD
- \$1465 profit from the Father Daughter Dance

SCRIP/School Supply Boxes - Nadia H. & Amanda H.

- School supply box sales are open for families to purchase with a deadline of July 1st, 2024
 - o 17 boxes sold YTD; 128 boxes were sold for 2023-2024 school year
 - o HSA will receive \$5.00 as a fundraiser for every box sold
 - o Marketing will go out June 1st to all St. Charles students and families
 - o Marketing will also be advertised in Weekly Rundowns for advertisement
- SCRIP YTD sales for 2023-2024 school year are \$9,310. Last year's equivalent was \$9,600 which does not include SCRIP buy-out numbers
- Mid-year letters were sent home with students in mid-March. This advertisement prompted new families to submit the buy-out payment and did see an increase in sales in March
