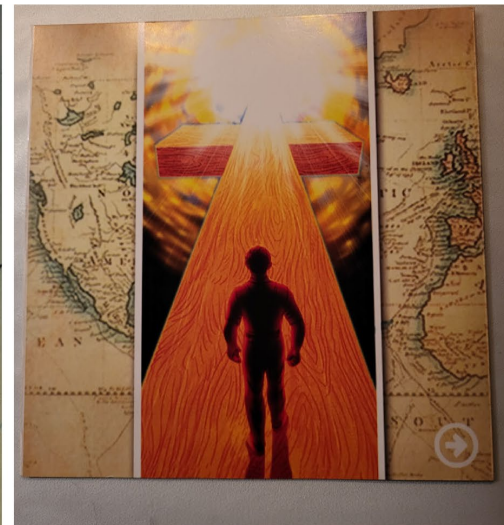
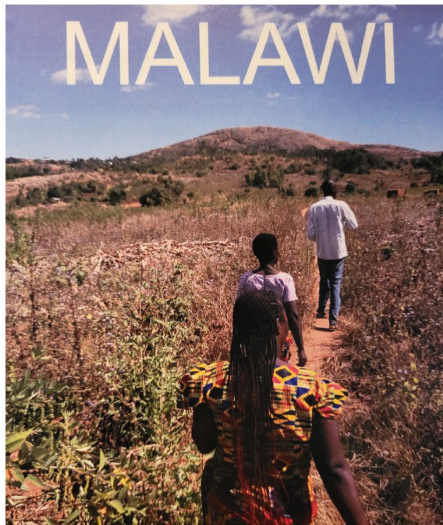

Missions Strategy

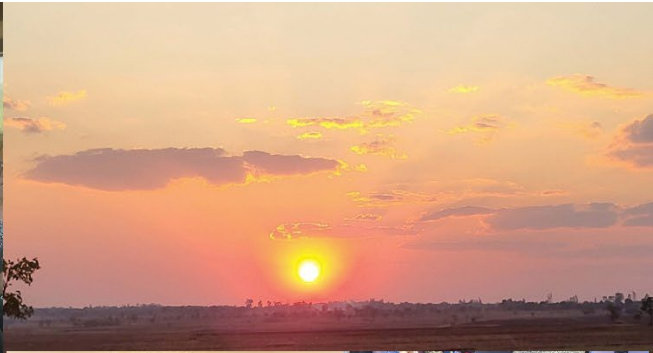

SHORT TERM MISSION TRIPS

How – continued

Entire trip is organized by e3partners for:

- Booking roundtrip airfare to/from country from JFK
- All in country ground transportation arranged
- All in country accommodations booked for trip duration
- 3 meals per day provided
- Average cost is \$4,000 per person (e3partner billing)
- 50% of e3partner billing contributed by GCCR for the first 10 people
- Go with someone from your small group or a couple or parent/youth.

Songea, Tanzania

The Lord is pouring out His Spirit in Tanzania. There is a great hunger for the gospel, and many people are putting their faith in Christ. The Lord is raising up His church in Tanzania. We will work with 20 to 30 existing churches to reach people in surrounding villages who have never heard the gospel, begin discipling them, and help them plant new churches in these villages.

Trip Information:

Departure Date: October 11, 2026

Team begins their journey from their home cities to travel to **Songea, Tanzania**.

What to expect: Team overnights in New York City on June 2nd, flies from JFK on the 3rd, overnights in Dar Es Salaam on the 4th and travels to Sumbawanga on the 5th. Each ministry day you will partner with local believers to share the gospel, train and disciple the believers, and plant new churches in villages where there are currently no churches.

Return Date: October 23, 2026

A Day on Mission

A Typical Day

The only thing we can guarantee about your day is that it will be a far cry from typical. Your activities and schedule will vary depending on the country where you work.

However, most trips follow a similar format:

- Early breakfast and devotional time with your team
- Meet with local partners and train on 4 Fields strategy and tools
- Depart for ministry location(s)
- Evangelism and discipleship throughout the day, “modeling” the tools learned in training with the nationals that morning, while looking for “Persons of Peace”
- Training new believers along the way
- Small group meetings
- Lunch in the field
- More evangelism and discipleship in the afternoon
- Depending on the country, your team may finish up in the late afternoon and head to the hotel for dinner.
- Others will continue their ministry after dinner.
