Powering Up New Ministries, Powering Down Our Building

Today we worship in our recently renovated Fellowship Hall! As you will have noticed, electrical power has been shut off in the original section of the church to replace the panels installed in 1963. This upgrade, made possible by our Legacy Campaign giving, is ongoing.

During this time, there will be no air conditioning or lights in the education wing, including the Sanctuary, Wesley Hall, and Respite Care. Events and activities in these spaces have been reassigned to rooms in our newer building. Sunday School classes, please check for classroom locations below.

Our WUMC Trustees understand that this necessary upgrade is disruptive to church ministries, but it is a temporary inconvenience for what will be a long-term improvement. We thank everyone for your patience and understanding.
