

Pastors' Bible Study

Join Pastor Dave beginning Wednesday, September 18, 7:00-8:30 p.m. in Rm 103 and Thursdays, beginning September 19, 10:30-noon via Zoom for *Set Free to Live Free! - a Thoughtful Consideration of Paul's Letter to the Galatians*, a journey back to the time when the Christian faith was strange, challenging, and radically new. We will spend six weeks on an intensive study of Galatians, one of the very earliest writings of the New Testament. We will consider fundamentally-relevant questions that all humans face: What does it mean to be free? How do you enjoy freedom? How can a person be good...and how good do you have to be to avoid trouble and still be "free?" Paul's Letter to the Galatians is full of wisdom, encouragement - and some rather sharp cautionary notes. No book is needed except your Bible.
