Early Christian Heretics: History Lessons starting January 5, 9:30-10:30 a.m. / Rm 174

Join the Marvin Willard Sunday School Class as Jeff Marston, a member of the class, will repeat his course that he taught in 2023 with Pastor Dave on the conflict of ideas between the "orthodox wing" of Christianity and those eventually deemed heretics. Jeff will use Old Testament and New Testament sources to explore the rocky road that was the development of early Christianity leading up to the famous Council of Nicaea in 325. Some of the issues to be explored will be: what is the nature of God; who did people think Jesus was; did a Christian have to be a Jew; and, should the age of Christian prophesy be closed? Although this will be a lecture course, questions will be encouraged. If you would like supplemental reading, Heretics for Armchair Theologians is an accessible read.
