Over the past year, a team of Williamsburg UMC members and staff has been hard at work exploring a better way to stay connected as a church family. After months of research, conversations with churches across the country, and in-depth comparisons, we're excited to share that we've chosen a new church management system: **REALM**.

Tom Justice led a small committee of WUMC members in conducting thorough due diligence—reaching out to congregations both locally and nationally to learn what worked (and what didn't) in real church settings. Their findings were compiled into a detailed comparison of options, which our staff then used to identify which platforms best met the needs of our ministries and day-to-day operations. **REALM** quickly stood out as the clear choice.

With **REALM**, we're gaining a powerful yet user-friendly system that will make it easier to:

- Communicate with your groups and teams
- RSVP for events and sign up for volunteer opportunities
- Update your own contact information and family profile
- Give online and track your giving history securely
- Access a digital directory of fellow members (you choose what's visible!) Our implementation process begins this month, starting with data migration and staff training. From there, we'll move into a three-month phased rollout—bringing in early

adopters to help test features, offer feedback, and support a smooth transition for everyone. We're committed to rolling this out in a way that feels peaceful, simple, and supportive, and we'll be offering plenty of guidance and tools to help you get comfortable with Realm. Stay tuned for more updates and opportunities to explore the platform for yourself. We truly believe Realm will help us deepen our relationships, strengthen our ministries, and make it easier for every member of our church family to stay informed and engaged.
