

This weekday afternoon ministry of Williamsburg United Methodist Church is open to all faiths and non-faiths. Our program provides time off for family members who care for dependent seniors by offering a safe, engaging, and nurturing environment where their loved ones can enjoy social activities, music, and companionship under the care of trained staff and volunteers. By supporting both seniors and their caregivers, Respite Care fosters a sense of community and ensures that no one has to navigate the caregiving journey alone.

### **EARLY CHILDHOOD MUSIC SCHOOL** williamsburgumc.org/ecms

ECMS is a weekday program offered to the community-at-large. Weekly classes in music and movement are taught by internationally certified early childhood music specialists. Through playful, engaging activities, children develop a strong foundation in rhythm, melody, and coordination while also enhancing their cognitive, social, and motor skills.

Parents and caregivers are encouraged to participate, creating a shared musical experience that fosters deeper connections and a lifelong love for music.

### KIDS MORNING OUT kidsmorningout.org

KMO is dedicated to providing a nurturing environment for children aged one to four. Our program fosters each child's social, emotional, cognitive, physical, and spiritual growth, while creating a support system for caregivers. Through age-appropriate activities, we aim to demonstrate God's unconditional love for all children. Our classes are divided into four age groups: Sprouts (young toddlers), Seedlings (twos), Saplings (threes), and Sycamores (fours). Each class is designed to meet the developmental needs of the children, providing a balance of structured learning and free play.



### **CREATION CARE TEAM**

Recycling and reducing water use helps to conserve a resource that is becoming scarce in parts of the world. By reducing or reusing wastewater, we can lessen the amount of freshwater that is withdrawn from lakes, rivers, and can help to mitigate the effects of drought. Here are 5 easy ways to reduce or

- 1. Avoid letting water run while brushing your teeth, shaving, or hand washing dishes.
- 2. Place a bucket in the shower while you're waiting for the water to warm up and use to flush the toilet, water plants or for cleaning tasks.
- 3. Run your clothes washer with full loads. Half-full loads can end up wasting over 500 gallons of water a month.
- 4. Reuse cooking water. Use nutrient-rich water from vegetables, pasta or rice to enhance the flavor or your dishes or let the water cool down and share with your plants for a natural fertilizer.
- 5. Changing your pet's water? Save water that's left to use on plants.
