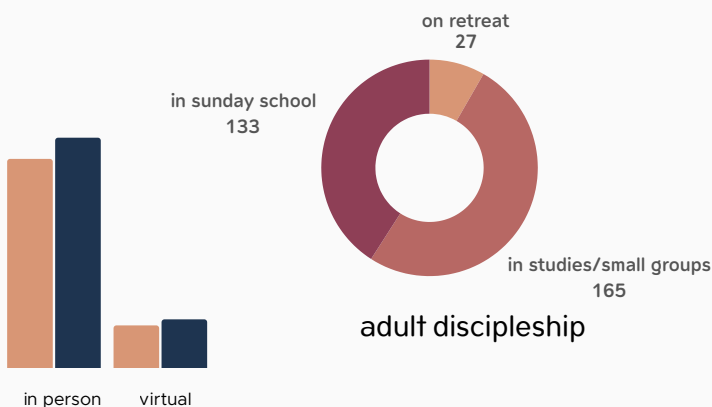

God takes what you give and multiplies it. This year's impact snapshot shows how your generosity becomes meals served, lives changed, music lifted, children taught, and hope restored.

Family Ministries

From **12** little ones in the nursery to **176** participants at Messy Church, faith was nurtured at every stage. Kids heard **47** godly play stories, **7** youth sorted **1,500** lbs. of food on our Mission & Arts tour, **4** Bibles were given to 3rd graders, **134** backpack tags were blessed, and **1** senior was awarded a scholarship. Families stepped into service, collecting **180** blankets, **35** bags of coats, **40+** bags of warm clothing, and **\$2,700** for Boone United Methodist Church after Hurricane Helene. Along the way, **864** slices of pizza were shared and **2,500** Easter eggs hidden (with **9** still being found months later!) – proof that joy multiplies, too.

Cornerstone Ministries

Respite Care: **21** members spanning **1,716** visits supported by **\$162,436** in tuition, **\$8,555** in donations, & **\$14,465** from fundraising events

Early Childhood Music School: over **650** students taught in more than **1,650** classes. **4** scholarships provided covering a total of **90** classes.

Kids Morning Out: welcomed **49** children with **14** graduating to kindergarten. **\$7,343** in scholarships awarded. Children enjoyed **15** chapels with our pastors and created **150** handprint turkeys for our Thanksgiving Meals ministry.

Carolina Honduras Foundation
6 members served in Limon, Honduras across **2** trips. WUMC provided funding for a med student, a child's hospital transfer, and food for families – multiplying the impact of care far beyond the team's hands.



Hope in the Mountains
12 members hosted **9** teen boys from West Virginia for life and job skills training. WUMC also helped fund municipal water access for **63** homes, **3** churches, and **1** volunteer fire department in Raleigh County, West Va.



Abukloi Secondary School
20 South Sudanese high school students were sponsored by **13** WUMC individuals, **2** WUMC classes, and **5** WUMC small groups – providing a total of **\$19,200** in support.
