



WEEK THREE: CHALLENGE

1. Read Acts 2:42–47. What does this passage reveal about the priorities and purpose of the early church? How do you see those same values reflected (or missing) in the church today?
2. *“Biblical community exists for something bigger than comfort.”* What are some ways we may unintentionally settle for spiritual comfort instead of embracing spiritual purpose?
3. Think about the “huddle” illustration from the sermon. In what areas do you see the church huddling but not moving? What might “running the play” look like?
4. Why is it important to see the church not just as a place you attend, but as a mission you’re a part of? How might that perspective shift the way you show up, serve, or share in the life of the church?

Weekly Challenge

Ask yourself this: Am I actively part of the mission God is unfolding through my church... or am I just in the room?

This week, reflect on one intentional way you can move from attending to participating — from comfort to calling — in the life of your church.
