



WEEK FOUR: THE SECOND CALL (3:1-4)

1. Jonah 3:1 says, “Then the word of the LORD came to Jonah a second time.” What does this show us about God’s mercy toward people who have failed?
2. God gave Jonah the same assignment again. Why do you think God often brings us back to the same place of obedience instead of giving us a different path?
3. The sermon said, “Obedience is not the enemy of grace.” How can obedience be part of God’s mercy rather than a way of earning His mercy?
4. Jonah’s warning to Nineveh was severe, but it was also merciful. Why is it loving for God to warn sinners about judgment rather than leave them alone?

Obey the next clear thing God has already shown you.

This week, prayerfully name one specific step of obedience you have been delaying. It may be confessing sin, forgiving someone, apologizing, ending something that is pulling you from God, or beginning something you know He has called you to do. Then take that step, trusting that God’s commands are not meant to crush you, but to call you back to life.
