



WEEK SIX: ANGRY AT MERCY (4:1-4)

1. Jonah was angry because God showed mercy to Nineveh. Why is it sometimes easier to receive mercy than to rejoice when someone else receives it?
2. Jonah knew true things about God: that He is gracious, compassionate, slow to anger, and abounding in love. How can we know true things about God and still have hearts that are not aligned with His?
3. Are there people or groups of people you quietly struggle to believe God could truly change? What does that reveal about your view of God's mercy?
4. God asked Jonah, "Is it right for you to be angry?" Where might God be asking you that same question right now?
