1. Jonah was “very happy” about the plant because it made him comfortable. What are some good gifts from God that can quietly become too important to us?
2. When the plant was taken away, Jonah’s anger exposed his heart. What is one comfort, preference, routine, or expectation that tends to reveal impatience, anger, or self-centeredness in you when it is disrupted?
3. Jonah cared more about his shade than about the souls of the people in Nineveh. Where are you most tempted to care more about your own comfort than the spiritual good of someone else?
4. God asked Jonah, “Should I not have concern?” Who is one person or group of people you struggle to have compassion for, and what would it look like to ask God to give you His heart toward them?
