1. What do 2 Kings 17 and Nahum 1 teach us about both the patience and the justice of God? Where do you see God warning people before judgment comes?
2. Why is it dangerous to mistake God's patience for His permission? Is there any area of your life where you have been saying, "I'll deal with that later"?
3. How does the cross show us that God is both perfectly just and abundantly merciful? Why would the gospel be incomplete if God simply ignored sin?
4. What conviction do you need to respond to quickly this week? What specific step of repentance, confession, obedience, or reconciliation is God calling you to take?

WEEKLY CHALLENGE

Respond quickly to conviction. Ask God to show you one area where you have delayed obedience or presumed His mercy. Write it down, confess it honestly, and take one clear step of repentance before the week is over.

Remember: God's warnings are not cruelty. They are mercy calling you back.



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
