## CAMP FOCUS

**CHECK-IN**

**Check-in is mandatory!** We will confirm students have turned in all forms/payments, students will receive their luggage tags, and students will pick up any squad shirts or merch purchased online. **Please DO NOT bring luggage to these check-ins!**

## PACKING LIST

### What to Bring:

- Casual clothing for 4-6 days
- Sunscreen
- Sunglasses
- Water bottle
- Bedding for bunk beds
- Towels, washcloths, and beach towel
- Toiletries including soap and shampoo
- Spending money for snacks, t-shirts, etc. (optional)
- Bible, pen, journal, etc.
- One suitcase
- One carry-on bag that can fit in the bus's overhead compartment.
- \*Sack Lunch on **Thursday** – There is no Buccee's on this trip, we are so sorry!!

### What not to Bring:

- Immodest clothes
- Bikinis (unless covered with a dark T-shirt)
- Tobacco, drugs, alcohol, fireworks, or any prank items.

### Immodest Clothing Examples:

- No low cut tanks
- No spaghetti strap tank tops
- No Bikinis (unless covered with a dark T-shirt)
- No thong swimsuits permitted at any time, full cover bottoms only
- Please wear shorts that are fingertip length

## SWIM TEST

All students who wish to swim, must take a swim test. **LEADERS CAN CHOOSE NOT TO TAKE A SWIM TEST** (You'll be confined to the shallow end of the pools and the Lake. Life jackets must be worn by students AND leaders at the lake.) If leaders/students PASS their swim test they must wear a wristband for the duration of camp. If your swim wrist band is lost- you must get a replacement. Students/Leaders may be required to take the swim test again. Students CAN NOT swim without a wrist band.

## NURSES/MEDICATION

- Medications must be in the original container.
- Medications must be dropped off to the nurse at check-in.
- Students will have to go to the Nurses Lodge in to take their medications.

## FAQ

### Will Middle School & High School be together?

Middle School Camp and High School Camp will both be at Lakeview Camp at the same time. However, just like in years past, our Middle Schoolers and High Schoolers will have separate schedules. They will have minimal crossover.

### What is adult supervision like at BSM Camp?

In addition to the 80+ regular serve team members that run life groups in BSM year-round, we have another 40+ adults that comprise our oversight teams (camp parents, worship team, nurses etc.). There are also multiple Beltway staff in attendance for specific roles or simply for additional oversight.

### My child has a food allergy. What are my options?

If your student has a known food allergy, please let us know as soon as possible, and have your student bring their own food. Lakeview Camp will store any allergy-sensitive foods your student may bring. If this applies to you Email [angiehervey@beltway.org](mailto:angiehervey@beltway.org)

### If my student is bringing medications, what do I do with them?

All medications need to be turned into the nurse at Check-in. Medication MUST be in the original bottle. There will be a form so you can write down what they are and when your student needs to take them. Students will be able to get medications from the nurse as needed, including at breakfast and before bed. To get Medication from the Nurses students must go to the nurse's cabin. Do not bring any over-the-counter medications. Those will be provided as needed. Nurses will have everything you may need in terms of over-the-counter medication.

### Are visitors allowed at Beltway Students Camp?

In order to ensure the safety and security of our campers, Lakeview Camp has implemented a strict "No Visitor" policy during all Summer camps.

### What does the swim test look like?

The students take the swim test without a life jacket. They need to be able to swim across the deep end of the pool without a life jacket. Lifeguards are standing by during the swim test in case a student or leader needs assistance.

What happens if students bring a cell phone or other electronic devices?
