From Pastor William

Jesus interferes with our lives. C.S. Lewis called Jesus the “Transcendental Interferer”. To be transcendental is to exist outside of the physical realm. It is to be above the world and all that it is in it. To interfere is to intervene or interrupt an activity without invitation. Interruptions can be rude and unwanted. However, they can also be helpful and life saving.

When Jesus came into the world, the Bible tells us the Son did not count equality with God a thing to be held on to, but instead He gave up His divine privileges by taking the position of a servant and being born as a human being. This was by God’s design and own initiative. Jesus wasn’t invited into creation. He chose to come for His own purpose, by His own design, and in the Father’s own timing. Jesus did not come to pat us on the back and tell us we are good. He didn’t even come to simply say we are broken. When God became a man in Christ Jesus, God the Son stepped into His creation to reveal our brokenness AND offer the opportunity of rescue that all of humanity needs.

The rescue that, Jesus offers us goes far beyond forgiveness. He offers us the opportunity to step out of brokenness into the healing and life made available by Him as we are born again into the kingdom of God. Over the next several months, we are going to walk through the gospel of John together with the hope that we will embrace the only One who can rescue us and give us new life in Him. Jesus is physical proof of God’s love for us, and His transcendental interference is what has saved us.

My prayer is that as we walk through the Gospel of John over the next several months, we will find Jesus more compelling, more precious, and worthy of all that we can give in our mission to follow Him and make disciples of all peoples.

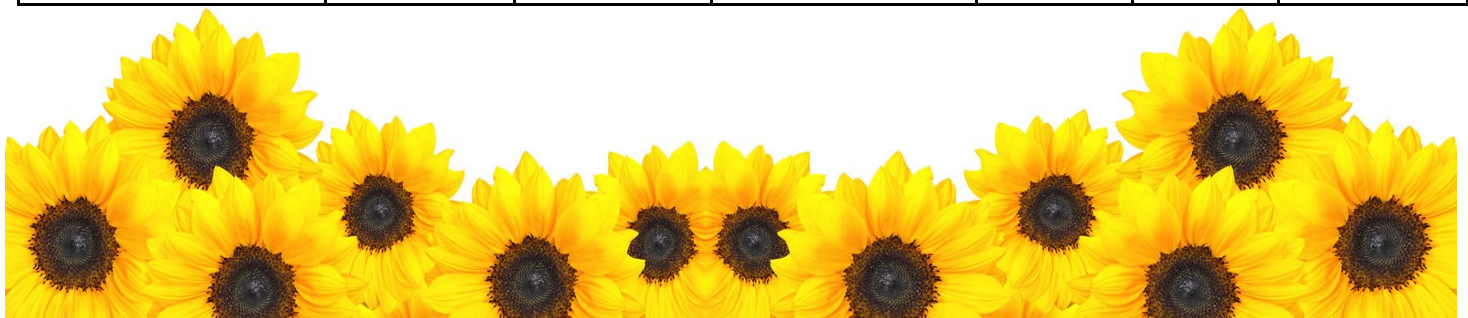
