Description: First Methodist Conroe is seeking two college-aged students (preferably rising freshmen or sophomores) to serve as Student Ministry Summer Interns. This is a paid, hands-on opportunity for students exploring a call to ministry and eager to grow in leadership, discipleship, and relational youth work.

Position Overview: Summer Interns will work closely with the Student Ministry Director to assist with programming, relational ministry, and summer events. This internship is designed to be practical and formational — giving interns meaningful responsibility while intentionally investing in their spiritual and leadership development.

Interns will take ownership of key areas of summer programming, not simply assist with tasks.

Time Commitment: Approximately 25 hours per week throughout the summer.

Compensation

- \$3,000 stipend for the summer (per intern)
- Housing and travel provided if necessary

Responsibilities

- Plan, oversee, and budget six summer student events
- Assist in programming and executing weekly student meetings
- Help lead summer trips, gatherings, and outreach events

- Build intentional relationships with middle and high school students
- Support communication and organization for ministry activities
- Participate in leadership meetings and planning sessions
- Assist with setup/teardown and logistical details of events

Interns will be entrusted with real leadership responsibilities, including managing event budgets, timelines, promotion, and volunteer coordination (with oversight and support).

Spiritual & Leadership Development

Interns will engage in a guided study of *Revisiting Relational Youth Ministry* by Andrew Root with the Student Ministry Director, including:

- Weekly one-on-one mentoring conversations
- Theological reflection on youth ministry philosophy
- Practical ministry application
- Personal spiritual growth and leadership development

Our goal is not simply to utilize interns for labor, but to invest in and equip future leaders of the Church.

Qualifications

- Rising college freshman, sophomore, or junior
- Demonstrates spiritual maturity and love for students
- Teachable, dependable, and relationally warm
- Interested in ministry, theology, or leadership development
- Organized and capable of managing responsibility
- Comfortable working with middle and high school students

Ideal Candidate

This position is ideal for a student who:

- Is exploring a potential call to ministry
- Wants hands-on leadership experience
- Values relational discipleship over performance-driven programming
- Is eager to grow in theological depth and practical leadership
- Is ready to take ownership of projects and see them through
