**KEYNOTE SPEAKER:** Dr. Thom S. Rainer is a renowned church leader, author, and consultant, currently serving as the founder and CEO of Church Answers, an online resource platform for church leaders. He previously held the positions of President and CEO at LifeWay Christian Resources and was the founding dean of the Billy Graham School of Missions and Evangelism at The Southern Baptist Theological Seminary. His expertise in church health led him to establish the Rainer Group, a consulting firm that has guided numerous churches and organizations. A prolific author, Rainer has contributed more than two dozen books to the field, including influential works such as "I Am a Church Member" and "Autopsy of a Deceased Church".

## **Breakout Session #1 (6:15-7:15 PM)**

Artificial Intelligence and Your Ministry: The New Fuel for Efficiency and Impact led by Scott Smith. This session introduces you to the dynamic world of Al. You will explore how Al can automate routine tasks, allowing more time for vital ministry work. Demonstrations will be given on how to maximize Bible study, including creating lessons, sermons and curriculum. We will also cover how Al can help you learn any subject five times faster. Ethical aspects of Al usage in a ministry context will be covered. You will leave with a good working knowledge of basic Al, and quickly become competent to implement Al into your personal day-to-day ministry and management.

<u>Babysitter vs Influencer</u> *led by Krista Staton.* Which are you? In this session you will learn simple steps to move from a babysitter to an influencer in the life of a child. We have a short time to make a difference in a child's life so come learn how to maximize the time that you have.

<u>Beyond Meat</u> *led by Toby Solberg.* Let's all agree there is no substitute for the real Word. Just like real meat can be hard to digest for some, how we present the Word may be hard to digest for many of our students. This interactive session will give you ideas and resources on how to take the goodness of God's Word and make it appetizing for the students in your ministry.

<u>Church Budgeting and Financial Issues</u> *led by Marc Amason.* Whether it be ideas to increase giving at your church or common mistakes churches make in dealing with finances, this session is for you. This session will help you increase giving, manage the finances of the church better, plus you'll learn how to avoid the mistakes churches make when dealing with finances.

<u>Current Trends and Common Practices in Turn-Around Churches</u> led by Dr. Thom Rainer. Our culture is changing rapidly and no one has a better pulse on culture and church than Dr. Thom Ranier. In this session you'll hear about the

latest research in culture and the impact on the church. This will be a rich discussion on ministry best practices and you'll have the opportunity for Q&A time with Dr. Rainer.

<u>Deacon Ministry Foundations</u> *led by Art Fulks and Gary Wood.* The ministry of deacons is foundational to healthy churches. In this breakout we will discuss both the spiritual/character aspects of healthy deacon ministry, but also invest in several practical tools to apply in caring and serving well.

<u>Disaster Relief in the 21st Century</u> *led by Dwain Carter.* There is much more to Georgia Baptist Disaster Relief than cooking food and chainsaws. Let's take a deeper look into the depths of the interworking of disciple making through DR.

<u>Effectively Engaging 18-25 Year Olds in the Local Church</u> *led by Kirk Richeson.* Whether they are in college or working, living at home or living on their own, young adults can seem like an elusive group for many churches to engage. Discover how to foster a spiritual atmosphere, build a cohesive worship team, and effectively communicate with congregants through music. We'll explore the balance between creativity and reverence; offering practical insights and strategies for cultivating a worship experience that resonates with both authenticity and excellence. Join us as we embark on a journey to elevate your worship and music leadership skills and inspire transformative worship encounters for the local church.

**Navigating Trauma in the Church** *led by Paula Walker.* Every church is filled with broken people. Many of them have lives filled with present or past adversity. In this session you will deepen your understanding of trauma and its impact on people and gain practical skills needed to minister with compassion inspired by the very heart of our Creator.

<u>Open Your Church to Deaf People</u> *led by Nathan Hill and Laramie Burris.* You can create opportunities for deaf people to worship and study the Bible in your church. Lay a foundation for a Deaf Ministry and enable deaf and hard of hearing people to participate in your church.

<u>Protecting Evangelism and Missions through Religious Freedom</u> led by Mike Griffin This class is about the theological and philosophical approach that churches should have regarding the rights of Religious Freedom in our country. Its goal is to help church leaders come away with a practical understanding that promotes evangelism and missions.

<u>Six Things Every Volunteer Needs to Know to Work with Teenagers</u> *led by Chris Trent.* In the constantly changing world of youth ministry, understanding the unique challenges and opportunities that come with working with teenagers is crucial for every volunteer. This session is designed to equip volunteers with the essential knowledge and skills needed to build discipleship focused relationships with teenagers and point them to Jesus.
