

# Endowment Committee Annual Report 2025

Distribution of money from the Endowment Fund has been made for the year 2025 per the enclosed chart. The total was developed according to the requirements detailed in the Constitution of Faith Lutheran Church that being: "About 75% of the Funds income be distributed each year (includes interest, dividend income and realized capital gain income) with the remaining 25% retained to grow the principal." The total also includes a \$1000 contribution from a Faith member.

This year members Bill Elmstrom, Kathy Norquist, Ted Lautzenheiser and Daniel Diemer submitted their resignations after many years of faithful service. Thank you for your contributions to this work!
