As the team prepares their testimonies, review what you should not say. You want to keep it relative to their environment.

Hi, my name is Mary (or Bob) Rothenburger. I was born in Evansville, Indiana, and moved to Terrell, Texas, when I was ten. I work for AT&T, developing blue-ray technology and selling blackberries.

I grew up unchurched and found Jesus when I was 20 years old. I am here today to bring Jesus to you.

I met Jesus through a friend in the Harley Davidson Club with me. We met at Starbucks before the Super Bowl Game, and he told me I was a sinner and needed Christ. If I didn't believe in Christ, he said I was going to hell. He said Jesus would remove my sin and make me white as snow.

And that's how I became a Christian. Would you like to pray with me?

## THREE GREAT TOOLS FOR SHARING THE GOSPEL

## THE AAA METHOD

- Ask great questions.
- Admire what you can about what they believe.
- Admit that you need Jesus too.

## **CLOSING QUESTIONS** THE GOSPEL IN SIX SENTENCES • Does that make sense? • God created us to be with Him. • Is there anything holding you • Our sins separate us from God. • Sins cannot be removed by back from trusting in Jesus good deeds. right now? • Paying the price for sin, Jesus died and rose again.

- Everyone who trusts in Him alone has eternal life.
- Life with Jesus starts now and lasts forever.
