

VILLAGE SUPPLIES COLLECTION LIST

GENERAL INFO

- These optional supplies will be carried to Brazil in the team's checked bags (except for the food pack option)*.
- Ensure your team knows the bag fees costs for your trip before deciding the volume of supplies your team will attempt to bring.
- Consider using SignUpGenius <https://www.signupgenius.com/> or a collaborative spreadsheet to track the amounts of your team's collected supplies.
- Don't fret over having enough supplies; just use what your team brings.
- Don't give any if you don't have enough supplies for men's or women's gift bags in a village.
- If you've promised gifts in the ministry but realize you don't have enough, have men/women line up by age and give to the oldest until supplies run out.
- Another alternative if running low is to have fun by using just a few gift bags and give them as a special prize to the ones that... answer questions, have the most kids, oldest, etc....
- If you have remaining gift supplies at the end of the trip, talk to your lead translator on how to best donate them.
- A rough estimate is to prepare 30 women's and 20 men's bags per village, with most teams covering four villages per trip. You do not have to give out bags in every village.
- VBS materials (refer to VBS Manual): 80 kids per village, 2 crafts per village/ morning and afternoon
- Please organize all the ministry closets after your trip
- Team leaders may make their collection list, but here are the most common items...

VILLAGES (Estimate 3 balls per village for men's, women's, and school teams).

- 12-15 regular Soccer Balls with small hand pumps and needles (size 5 preferred)
- 2-3 eBalls for missionaries and pastors (optional)

- Canvas Tote Bags
- Dish Towels or Hot Pads
- Toiletries
- Nail polish with supplies (clippers, files, cotton)

MEN'S (Gift bags used during Men's Ministry)

- Fishing Line 40 lb. and Hooks (variety)

- Caps
- Flashlights and batteries
- Small Pocket Knives

PHARMACY (Full Formulary in Managed Missions under "Important Team Info" link)

- Numbers are per trip average, but more are welcomed
- 15 tubes Hydrocortisone Cream 1% (30 gm)
- 15 tubes of Triple Antibiotic Ointment (30mg)
- 3000 tablets of Acetaminophen (500mg)
- 1200 tablets Prenatal Vitamins w/ iron
- 1200 tablets Children's Vitamins w/ iron

- 2000 tablets Adult Multivitamin w/ minerals
- 3000 tablets Ibuprofen (200mg)
- 6 bottles Artificial Tears (15ml or 30ml)
- 4 Saline Nasal Spray (100ml or 120ml)
- 400 Ziploc-type sandwich bags
- 2 Black Sharpies

- 2 Small Bottles of Lysol Concentrate (used for chigger solution bucket)
- Light Color Duct Tape
- 6 Sharpie Markers
- All Sizes of Ziploc Bags, including pill size
- Peanut Butter
- Jam
- Pancake Syrup
- Small party supplies and small translator gifts (for a thank-you party last night is the norm, but not required.)

FOOD PACKS (\$35ea)

- Some teams opt to raise funds for food packs instead of bringing men's and women's ministry supplies.
- Prepared in Brazil and on the boat when the team arrives
- One pack provides staple food items for a family for a month
- The missionary will decide how to distribute the food packs best
- A separate "Food Pack" fundraising link can be created for the team
- We must know the amount of food packs a minimum of two weeks before the trip
