SERIES TITLE: Becoming More Like Jesus PART ONE: GROWING LIKE JESUS TEXT: LUKE 2:41-52

INTRODUCTION.

- What character traits in Jesus are revealed in this passage?

- Which of those traits do you most want to imitate and improve in your own life?
- Has your hunger for God ever been misunderstood by your family or friends? Why?
- How is it possible to balance serving/worshiping God with all the responsibilities/demands of everyday life?
- Fact: What is a key truth that you understood from this passage?
- React: What did you feel?
- Act: What are you going to do?
