Thanks to everyone who has been joining us in Fellowship Hall on the 2nd and 4th Tuesdays of the month. We have a lovely area to meet and Julie and I are very pleased with the set up, albeit that we do need to “haul” things back and forth to the storage area.

Our May meetings will be great:

On May 12th we will be packing about 550 pencil packs. These will be set aside and added to others we assemble for the Congregational Packing Party in November. We will also decorate inserts, laminate tic tac toe sheets (cut them to fit inside the bags too) and if all supplies are available we will make tic tac toe bags. We will also work on jump rope kits and braiding jump ropes. We will have some other small projects too.

On May 26th we will make craft kits and tic tac toe bags if we did not finish them on May 12th. We will also work on jump rope kits and braid jump ropes. More projects will be available (hard to know at this point)

Dates we meet in June will be June 9 and 23. Dates we meet in July will be July 14 and 28. In August we will only meet on August 11th.

Special note: Jump rope kits can usually be picked up on the Tuesdays that we meet or in a cabinet marked “OCC” in Fellowship Hall. Braided jump ropes can be returned on the Tuesdays we meet or dropped in the Donation bin marked “Completed Jump ropes”.
