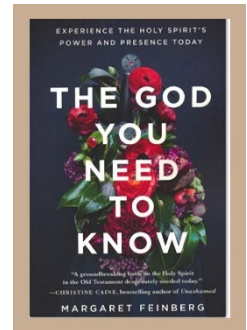

LEVEL 2 STUDY



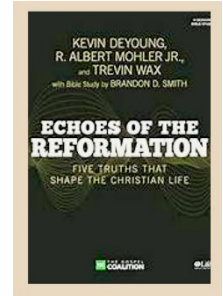

LEVEL 2 STUDY

It has been five hundred years since Martin Luther nailed his 95 Theses to the door of the All Saints' Church in Wittenberg, Germany. Luther's theses called for the reform of the church and served as the catalyst for the Protestant Reformation. This Bible study is biblically rooted and gospel centered. It examines the five core truths that came from the Reformation, now referred to as the *solas*.

How is the Reformation still relevant today? As political pressure mounts, morality drifts with today's culture, the *solas* points us to vibrant Christian community as well as personal identity in Christ. We stand on the shoulders of Christians in the past, and knowing where we came from will help us keep moving forward with passion and biblical clarity.

Benefits:

- Give group members a better understanding of the Reformation's impact on today's church.
- Understand the weighty importance of the inspired Word of God.
- Help group members discern the theological nuances of grace and its role in the life of a disciple.
- Enhance a believer's understanding of the biblical and historical depth of the Christian faith.
- Realize that Christ alone provides all of life's answers.
- Show group members how to live life for the glory of God and renew their commitment to this biblical mandate.

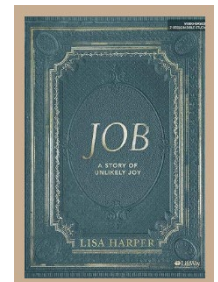

LEVEL 3 STUDY

Before there were kings in the land of Israel, there were judges assigned and appointed by God – the TRUE KING OF ISRAEL. In the inductive Bible study on the first book of Samuel, we explore the Israelites transition from judges to kings through the experience and perspective of the prophet Samuel. Explore the story of Samuel's birth and the precious way God calls him to ministry. Witness Israel's request for a King and their rejection of God as King. Dive into the stories of kings Saul and David. Trace the journey of the Ark of the Covenant from capture to restoration. From judges to kings, from the departure of God's glory to the assurance of His help, from inquiring of the Lord to inquiring of a medium – this book of contrasts sets before us the importance of a life of obedience and how it is lived out during interpersonal conflicts.

Joy is the constant companion of the woman who trusts in the Lord. While you can find it in friends, family and circumstances, unfailing, persistent joy will only ever overflow from your relationship with Jesus. Just ask Job, the man from Uz who clung to God's goodness while all his worldly joys were stripped away. But how is it possible to hold onto such joy in times of sorrow? In this study, discover the redemptive facet of Job's suffering. Learn to view pain as a way to strengthen your faith, point others to the gospel, and trust in the Lord. His providence will never take you to a place where His grace will not sustain you.

LEVEL 3 STUDY

Learn the principles of exemplary Christian living. Understand the spiritual warfare, sparked by the presence of the Gospel in the world and the rapture of the Church – God’s ultimate rescue. In our study on 1 Thessalonians, we will observe Paul’s encouragement to the young church in Thessalonica, focusing on themes of faith, love, hope, the importance of holy living, and the anticipation of Christ’s return.

Participants will discover the meaning of 1 Thessalonians in the context of scripture. We will apply what we are learning to our life as we discover the truth for ourselves. Him, you will draw closer to God with a deeper desire to serve Him faithfully. Be encouraged to dig deeper into the presence of God, listen for His voice, and experience the depths of His Spirit. Learn to place yourself in a position to hear the voice of God. Understand the pitfalls that often keep you from hearing from the Lord.
