

People who laugh with friends, weep with grief, carry on doing the best they can. Just like us.


We must be open to discover who we might know, like, and trust.

• The Sacrament of Holy Communion


The Lord be with you: and also with you.

Give us this day our daily bread.


And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us.

Then help us offer that grace to others.


Help us and our gifts be used to welcome everyone,
