Policy for Students with Life-Threatening Allergies

BACS IS NOT A NUT FREE OR OTHER FOOD RESTRICTED CAMPUS.



The parent/guardian will be responsible for making BACS staff aware of the child's allergy.



The parent/guardian must supply the school with medications (EpiPen's, Antihistamines, inhalers, etc.).



The parent/guardian will be required to provide doctor's orders for ALL medications.



BACS brings in food from outside sources and the parent will be responsible for reviewing menu ingredients and options before placing food orders for their student.



The parent/guardian of a student with a life-threatening allergy must provide snacks for their own student in the event that a teacher allows for snack time.

BACS will not enforce restrictions on our students in regards to food products brought on campus and therefore, it is the responsibility of the parent of the student with a life-threatening allergy to provide or approve all food products.
