Is there an action God is calling me to take or refrain from taking? Is there a character trait God is seeking to form within me?

How does this passage speak to my life as a disciple who abides in Jesus, is becoming like Jesus, does what Jesus, and who multiplies my faith by making more disciples?

Who is God calling me to share what I have learned with?
