

Sermon Discussion Guide (5/18)

Begin the discussion by checking in with each person present and share prayer requests/praises with the group. Then, have one person offer a prayer for the group making sure to include any prayer requests that were mentioned earlier.

## Scripture

Read Ephesians 3:14-21 out loud. Discuss any initial thoughts you have about these verses.

## Observation

What does this Scripture reveal to us about what God can do? What does this Scripture reveal to us about the way that God does immeasurably more?

How do you see God's grace at work within this passage?

Read Ephesians 2:1-10. What does this Scripture reveal to us about our need for God?

What does this Scripture reveal to us about the nature of faith? Based on this passage, how would you define faith? What is faith? What is faith not?

## Application

How might God be calling you to expand your vision and trust in Him to do more than you can imagine? As you reflect on this question, remember that immeasurably more is not just about numbers but is about discipleship and planting deep spiritual roots within our lives and the lives of others.

In Pastor Kenny's sermon, he said that God's power works through us when we say "yes" and not when we feel ready or have everything figured out. In what area of your life is God calling you to say "yes" to Him? What challenge or obstacle is presently keeping you from getting out of the boat and saying "yes" to God? How can you overcome this obstacle?

The immeasurably more that God calls us to is not about our own comfort but about passing down the faith to future generations. What kind of legacy do you want your faith to leave for the next generation? How can you begin to lay the foundations for that legacy, for the glory of God?

In Pastor Kenny's sermon, he explained that the Immeasurably More series is ultimately about trust and surrender. How is God calling you to more fully surrender your life to Him? What step of obedience will you take this week in response to God's call?

## Prayer

Jesus, we believe that You are the God of Immeasurably More. Today, we surrender our hearts, our dreams, and our lives to You. Do more than we ask or imagine in our lives, in Your Church, and throughout the world. Not just for this season, but for generations to come.
