Sermon Title: Faithful in the Fire: Standing Strong When Others Bow

Sermon Scripture: Daniel 3:16-18



Sermon Discussion Guide (7/06)

Begin the discussion by checking in with each person present and share prayer requests/praises with the group. Then, have one person offer a prayer for the group making sure to include any prayer requests that were mentioned earlier.

Scripture

Read Daniel 3:8-18 out loud. Discuss any initial thoughts you have about these verses.

Observation

In what ways do Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego show defiance to cultural idols?

In the exchange between Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego and King Nebuchadnezzar, who or what specifically do Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego place their faith in? Who or what do they not place their faith in?

Read Daniel 3:19-29. Who is with Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego while they are in the fire? What does this event reveal to us about the character of God?

According to verses 28-29, what is the end result of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego's decision to stand strong and refuse to bow down to idols? What does this result reveal to us about how God may use our willingness to stand strong when others bow?

Application

Where in your life are you facing pressure to bow to cultural expectations or idols? What are these idols promising you? What costs will you have to endure to resist bowing to them?

Why do you think we are often drawn to a belief that God exists to make our lives easier or that choosing to be a Christian means we will not have to go through difficult situations? How might this perspective be an obstacle to standing strong in situations when it would be easier to bow?

In the Scripture, we saw that God did not rescue Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego <u>from</u> the fire but instead was <u>with</u> them in it. When have you experienced God strengthening you and being with you so that you could stand strong even though it came at a personal cost? How does remembering what God has done in the past give you courage in facing present struggles?

Where in your life do you need to renew your faith in Christ so that you can say, "Even if He doesn't, I will still trust You"?

Prayer

Lord, give us the courage to stand strong when the world bows to idols of comfort, power, and popularity. Help us to trust in who You Are. May we know that You are God even when you don't take us out of the fire. Remind us that You are always with us, strengthening our faith and shaping our hearts. Help us to stand firm in the face of temptation, not for the applause of people, but to bring glory to Your name. Jesus, You walked through the ultimate fire for us and now we pray that you would teach us to walk faithfully in Your grace. Amen.
