Connie Kuntz and Ann Fenwick are helping again this year to educate the children of our church family.

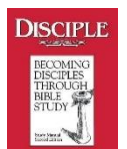
There is always a need for extra volunteers to assist the 2 of us to offer consistent coverage for 2 age groups.
