ALWAYS PRAYING, ALWAYS GROWING | OCTOBER 6, 2024

SERMON RECAP

We are called to be always praying and always growing. Spiritual growth, maturity, and knowledge of God's will are not possible apart from being in Christ. Your walk with Him matters!

THE LEAD IN

- Has anyone ever prayed for you in a way that deeply impacted you and you won't ever forget it? Why was it so memorable? What was the impact of that prayer on your walk with Christ?

GETTING INTO THE TEXT

- Read Colossians 1:9-14. Paul is writing out his prayer for the church in Colossae. What strikes you about what he prays for the people? What is his desire for the church he's writing to?
- Paul prays a similar prayer for the Ephesian church in Ephesians 3:14-21. How are these two prayers similar? Do we pray for people the way that Paul models prayer for others for us?

GOING DEEPER

- How can we understand what God's will is for our lives? What has He given us to help discern His will? How do you seek to know His will in your walk with Him?
- Why does your walk with the Lord matter? Is "living a life worthy of the Lord" just legalism? If it's not, what is the goal? How can we accomplish that goal?

PRAYER

- This passage in Colossians is a prayer. As you close in prayer together, pray these things over each other that Paul prayed for the church in Colossae.
