PEACE LEADS THE WAY | DECEMBER 8, 2024

SERMON RECAP

We need the peace of Christ to rule in our hearts to reconcile broken relational situations. It is no ordinary peace.

THE LEAD IN

- Why is peace such an elusive goal, both in culture, between governments, and between people?

GETTING INTO THE TEXT

- Read Colossians 3:12-15. The word “rule” is a strong word in verse 15. What might it look like for Christ’s peace to rule in your heart?
- Why do you think the phrase “And be thankful” was included at the end of verse 15? The surrounding context, all the way back to Colossians 3:1 may be helpful in considering this.

GOING DEEPER

- What is your natural default when addressing a broken situation in a relationship? Do you need to stew on it? Do you need time to process? Do you yell it out right away? Does your typical response show a submission and desire for Christ’s peace?
- Are you dealing with a broken situation in a relationship? Are you willing to share about it? How might you be able to approach it with the peace of Christ ruling in your heart?

PRAYER

- Pray for each other and the situations that have caused brokenness. Ask God for the humility for His peace to rule in your hearts.
