SERMON RECAP

Let the words from God, about God, and what God has done, dwell in your heart.

THE LEAD IN

- If you weren't a disciple of Jesus Christ, where would you be right now? How would your life look differently?

GETTING INTO THE TEXT

- Read Colossians 3:16. How might psalms, hymns, and songs be used to teach and admonish one another? Why does Paul link new life in Christ and singing?

GOING DEEPER

- We started by asking how our lives might look differently if we weren't disciples of Christ. Was that a convicting question? Are there spaces in your life that don't look different even though you follow Christ? What are those areas? What do you need to surrender?
- Would you consider yourself a good singer? If so, how does singing influence your walk with the Lord? If not, same question — how does, or maybe should, singing influence your walk with the Lord?
- Alex said that words from God, words about God, and testimonies of God's people should dwell in our hearts. How can we cause that to be true? How could singing play a role?

PRAYER

- Exodus 15:1-18 is the first recorded worship song in the Bible. Have someone read it aloud as a prayer. Then continue in prayer, praising God for the same things that the people of Israel did thousands of years ago.
