SERMON RECAP

THE LEAD IN

- Share a story about when a change of direction in life or an unexpected event led to something positive.

GETTING INTO THE TEXT

- Read Philippians 1:1-6. How does Paul feel about the people in the church in Philippi? How does that affect the way that he prays for them?
- Acts 16 tells the stories of Lydia and a jailer and his family who came to know the Lord. Consider that history as you read Philippians 1:6. What is Paul encouraging the Philippian church with?

GOING DEEPER

- Paul didn't intend to go to Macedonia where Philippi was. But God changed his direction, and we see the depth of relationship that resulted. Think back to the story you shared in the Lead In. What relationships or experiences are you grateful for that may not have happened if God hadn't changed the direction of your life?
