SERMON RECAP

Having the same mindset of Christ calls us to humility, not selfish ambition or vain conceit. This unifies the church and glorifies God.

THE LEAD IN

- C.S. Lewis said, “Humility is the only virtue that, the moment you think you have it, you’ve lost it.” Discuss this quote and what it means.

GETTING INTO THE TEXT

- Read Philippians 2:1-5. In the midst of this section on unity with others, why would Paul speak so forcefully about the danger of pride? Why is pride so destructive to unity in the church?
- Jesus is our model of humility. Consider some of the following verses (John 5:19, 30, 41; 6:38; 7:16, 28; 8:28, 42, 50; 14:10, 24). How did Jesus demonstrate humility throughout His life on earth?

GOING DEEPER

- Tom shared the ways that pride can exhibit itself in our lives: selfish ambition, vain conceit, a misunderstanding of valuing others above ourselves, self-degradation, and self-demotion. Of this list, where does pride show up in your life most often or easily?
- Consider two areas where humility is important, your relationships with others and unity in the body of Christ. Who do you struggle in relationship with because of pride? How would humility change that relationship? How might your role in the body be affected?

PRAYER

- Confess areas of pride and ask God to develop within you the mindset of Christ.
