BECOMING WHO YOU ALREADY ARE | DECEMBER 14, 2025

SERMON RECAP

Jesus came at Christmas to free us from sin and give us new life. As His children, we abide in Him daily by fighting sin and living in the new identity He's given us.

THE LEAD IN

- Christmas is often a season of joy and celebration. Why does it matter that we still talk about sin during the Christmas season?

GETTING INTO THE TEXT

- Read 1 John 3:4-6. Why does John describe sin as lawlessness? What does that reveal about the seriousness of sin?
- Consider the context of 1 John. Look at 1:8 and 2:1. How do those verses help us interpret the strong language that John uses in 3:6?

GOING DEEPER

- We're aware of the "big" sins and for the most part can avoid them, but what about the subtle, everyday sins like self-reliance, people-pleasing, pride, or refusing to forgive. What "respectable" sins are easiest for you to overlook in your own life?
- Abiding means to rest, remain, and walk with Christ. How do you do this daily? What things disrupt your ability to abide?

PRAYER

- As you pray, thank God for sending Christ to remove sin and give us new life in Him. Confess sin together and spend time in praise of who God is.
