From the Desk of the Pastor:

The new school year has started at Northwest Lutheran School, Milwaukee Lutheran High School, and many of our area Lutheran schools. The theme for the 2025-2026 school year at Northwest is "Make a Joyful Noise to the Lord" based on Psalm 98:4. The psalmist recalls the might and mercy of God who has done marvelous things and has worked salvation for His people.

He was no doubt remembering how God had delivered His Old Testament people, the Israelites, from slavery in Egypt. They had been enslaved by Pharoah and forced into hard labor to build cities for Pharoah. Yet, God loved Israel and was faithful to His chosen people. So, like those ancient Israelites, we can shout for joy to the Lord, we can make a joyful noise, because God has delivered us from slavery to sin and death, He is with us on our journey through life, and He will bring us safely home to heaven to live with Him forever.




