

Jonah – Salvation Belongs to the Lord The Storm and the God Who Pursues Jonah 1:4-16

Big Truth of this Series: From beginning to end, salvation is of the Lord! God's holy justice is balanced with His magnificent grace and mercy and is extended to everyone who believes the gospel message, repents, and turns to Him.

Big Truth of Today's Message: God sent a violent storm as He pursued His prophet Jonah for restoration and the pagan sailors for salvation.

v. 4-6 – God pursues Jonah and the sailors by sending a violent storm.

v. 7-10 – Jonah "forgot" who he was and what he was called to do.

v. 11-16 – The solution to sailors' problem was the death of God's prophet.
