Salvation in the Midst of Chaos

Psalm 27

Notes:

- ¹ The LORD is my light and my salvation;
whom shall I fear?
The LORD is the stronghold of my life;
of whom shall I be afraid?
- ² When evildoers assail me
to eat up my flesh,
my adversaries and foes,
it is they who stumble and fall.
- ³ Though an army encamp against me,
my heart shall not fear;
though war arise against me,
yet I will be confident.
- ⁴ One thing have I asked of the LORD,
that will I seek after:
that I may dwell in the house of the LORD
all the days of my life,
to gaze upon the beauty of the LORD
and to inquire in His temple.
- ⁵ For He will hide me in His shelter
in the day of trouble;
He will conceal me under the cover of His tent;
He will lift me high upon a rock.
- ⁶ And now my head shall be lifted up
above my enemies all around me,
and I will offer in His tent
sacrifices with shouts of joy;
I will sing and make melody to the LORD.
- ⁷ Hear, O LORD, when I cry aloud;
be gracious to me and answer me!
- ⁸ You have said, “Seek My face.”
My heart says to You,
“Your face, LORD, do I seek.”
- ⁹ Hide not Your face from me.
Turn not Your servant away in anger,
O You who have been my help.
Cast me not off; forsake me not,
O God of my salvation!
- ¹⁰ For my father and my mother have forsaken me,
but the LORD will take me in.
- ¹¹ Teach me Your way, O LORD,
and lead me on a level path
because of my enemies.
- ¹² Give me not up to the will of my adversaries;
for false witnesses have risen against me,
and they breathe out violence.
- ¹³ I believe that I shall look upon the goodness of
the LORD in the land of the living!
- ¹⁴ Wait for the LORD;
be strong, and let your heart take courage;
wait for the LORD!
