- ³⁹ But I say to you, Do not resist the one who is evil. But if anyone slaps you on the right cheek, turn to him the other also.

- Taken Out of Context

PUNISHMENT "FIT" THE CRIME:

God meant it to protect the weak, helpless - Was supposed to be the "limit" for punishment -Keepers of the Law used it as the standard, and the expectation!

Personal Response (HEART)

- Love, Forgive, Overly Generous, Caring, and Willing
- Civil Response (JUST)
- Honest, Fair, and Truthful Without Pity and Seeking Justice

Jesus is saying - Turn our situations of "control or weakness" into opportunity for Intentionality, Compassion, and Love

- Walk the Extra Mile

- Return Insult with Love
- Give More Than Expected
- Heart Response

- ⁴³ "You have heard that it was said, 'You shall love your neighbor and hate your enemy.'
- ⁴⁴But I say to you, Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you,
- ⁴⁵ so that you may be sons of your Father who is in heaven. For he makes his sun rise on the evil and on the good and sends rain on the just and on the unjust. ⁴⁶ For if you love those who love you, what reward do you have? Do not even the tax collectors do the same? ⁴⁷ And if you greet only your brothers, what more are you doing than others? Do not even the Gentiles do the same?

Love Your Neighbor - Hate Your Enemy (In the Law) (Added to the Law)

- Jesus is NOT ignorant here... He knows we all have enemies He says Love Them!
- Luke 10:25-37 Good Samaritan
 - Jesus says that Neighbors includes your enemies!

"<u>Sons</u> (Huios) of your Father who is in Heaven"

Nepios, Paidion, Teknon & Huios

Greek - Four Stages Spiritual Maturity.

Nepios (infants)

Paidion (young child)

Teknon (spiritual teenagers)

Huios (mature sons)

Maturity is NOT knowing what to do....

Maturity is Doing what you know – NO MATTER WHAT

A Change of Heart NOT Just A Change of Actions
