- **176 verses (longest chapter in scripture)**
- **22 sections - 8 verses in each section**
  - **22 letters Hebrew language**
  - **Each verse starts with that letter**
- **Psalm 119**
  - **Thought to be David's "Life Work"**
  - **Like Solomon's "Wisdom Books"**
  - **Focus – Glorify God & His Word**
  - **"Scripture" in 171 out of 176 verses**

## Psalm 119:1-8 (Aleph N)

<sup>2</sup> **Blessed are those who keep His *testimonies*,**

<sup>3</sup> **who also do no wrong,**

**but walk in His *ways*!**

**BLESSED** – Beatitudes Jesus “redefines”  
blessed. (Matthew 5:3-12) Focused on Love

**BLAMELESS** – Psalm 19:13 *“Keep your  
servant also from willful sins; may they not  
rule over me. Then I will be blameless  
innocent of great transgression.”*

**WHOLE HEART** – Life-Transforming  
Process

**WALK** – Relationship, intimacy, seeking  
Him

## Psalm 119:1-8 (Aleph N)

- <sup>5</sup> Oh that my ways may be steadfast  
in keeping Your *statutes!*
- <sup>6</sup> Then I shall not be put to shame,  
having my eyes fixed on all Your  
*commandments.*
- <sup>7</sup> I will praise You with an upright heart,  
when I learn Your righteous *rules.*
- <sup>8</sup> I will keep Your *statutes;*  
do not utterly forsake me!

“needed”

**EYES FIXED** – No distractions or  
mistrust. “Peter walking on water”

**UPRIGHT HEART** – genuine, pure,  
honest – a reflection of the affection
