in Your *Rules*.**

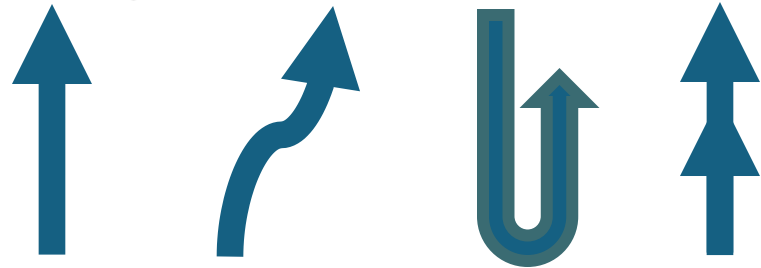
