⁵⁰ This is my comfort in my affliction, that Your *Promise* gives me life.

⁵¹ The insolent utterly deride me, but I do not turn away from Your *Law*.

⁵² When I think of Your *Rules* from of old, I take comfort, O Lord.

Verses 49-52

REMEMBER – God does not “forget”

“Jerusalem, I have put guards on the walls to watch. - They must not be silent day or night.

COMFORT – Not comfortable, but peace
