"It is time for the LORD to act, for Your Law has been broken"

Retributive (Punish) Restorative (Love)

"Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I have not come to abolish them but to fulfill them" - Matthew 5:17

For whoever shall keep the whole law, & yet stumble in one point, is guilty of all. - James 2:10

- 132 Turn to me and be gracious to me, as is Your Way with those who love Your Name.

- Vertical Love (Love God)




Psalm 119:129-136 (Pe 2)
