THe Mystery

- The Unknown plan of God
- Paul talks about a lot here:
 - Prisoner of Christ Jesus
 - Stewardship of the "Gentile Grace"
 - No one knew about this "plan"
 - But is NOW being revealed
 - So... What is the Mystery?



- ⁶ This mystery is that the Gentiles are fellow heirs, members of the same body, and partakers of the promise in Christ Jesus through the Gospel.
- ⁷Of this Gospel I was made a minister according to the gift of God's grace, which was given me by the working of His power.
- ⁸ To me, though I am the very least of all the saints, this grace was given, to preach to the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ,
- ⁹ and to bring to light for everyone what is the plan of the mystery hidden for ages in God, Who created all things,

 Ephesians 3:6-9



- We are ALL heirs and part of the SAME Body
- We can ALL experience the "unsearchable riches of His grace"
- This was God's plan all along
