

One Body - The Church

With Christ as head - Believers are members of one body, to one another and for Christ.

1 Corinthians 12:13 "For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one BODY. Whether Jews or Greeks or slaves or free, we were all made to drink of the one Spirit"

One Spirit - The Holy Spirit

As believers we have received the Spirit. "The Helper," - So we can be HIS witnesses.

Galatians 5:16 "But I say, live by the SPIRIT and you will not carry out the desires of the flesh"

ONE HOPE & CALL

Live in a manner worthy of the calling to which you have been called.

One Hope - Salvation and the Gospel

Titus 2:13 "as we wait for the joyous fulfillment of our HOPE in the glorious appearing of our great God and Savior, Jesus Christ."

One Call - The Gospel

Revelations 17:14 "They will make war with the Lamb, but the Lamb will conquer them, because he is Lord of lords and King of kings, and those accompanying the Lamb are the CALLED, chosen, and faithful."

ONE LORD, ONE FAITH, ONE BAPTISM One Lord – Jesus Christ

Romans 10:9 - "because, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is LORD and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved."

One Faith - Salvation and Justification

Ephesians 2:8-9 - "For by grace you have been saved through FAITH. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast."

One Baptism – Immersion into Jesus

Romans 6:3 - Or do you not know that as many as were BAPTIZED into Christ Jesus were BAPTIZED into his death?

One God - Three in one (The Trinity)

Deuteronomy 6:4 "Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is ONE."

One Father – Of Christ and Believers
John 14 – ALL OF IT!

John 1:12 – "But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God."
