Submission <u>IS NOT</u> Blind Ignorance... Submission <u>IS</u> Confidently Following!

²² Wives, submit to your own husbands, as to the Lord.

²³ For the husband is the head of the wife even as Christ is the head of the Church, His Body, and is Himself its Savior.

²⁴ Now as the church submits to Christ, so also wives should submit in everything to their husbands.

- ²⁵ Husbands, love your wives, as Christ loved the church and gave Himself up for her,
- ²⁶ that He might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word,
- ²⁷ so that He might present the church to Himself in splendor, without spot or wrinkle or any such thing, that she might be holy and without blemish.
- ²⁸ In the same way husbands should love their wives as their own bodies. He who loves his wife loves himself.
- ²⁹ For no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, just as Christ does the church,
- ³⁰ because we are members of his body.
