Adults join St. Paul through our A.I.M. class. A.I.M. stands for: "Adult Introduction to Membership." Essentially, it's a class that 'aims' (pun intended) to teach the essentials of the Christian faith and prepare you for baptism (if you haven't been baptized), for receiving the Lord's Supper, and for being a member at St. Paul Lutheran Church. The class is constructed so that each session builds upon the previous; by the end, you'll understand why Christians use the Bible, who God is, what faith is and why it's important for you, how God has worked in your life, and how Christians respond to God's gifts. We believe the Christian faith is the most important knowledge that exists – it's the only information that has eternal implications; the ultimate purpose of this course is to teach you that essential information. (Along the way, you'll have the opportunity to ask any questions that you may have, as well).

Additionally, the class will introduce our church to you, explain what we believe as a church, and describe how our beliefs flow out into what we do. We want you to be comfortable worshipping at our services and to be encouraged to get involved. That's why we ask that all incoming members take this course – even those who've been lifelong Lutherans. Through the class, you'll also get to know our pastors and meet others who are joining the church.

A.I.M. is our invitation to you to join our church – we hope and pray that after the class is over, you'll join us as we worship God in spirit and in truth, serve others as God has served us, and work to "Connect people to Christ" so that they might also know of God's love for them!
