Program Availability

Open -7:00 am—5:30 pm year round

Closed—New Year's Day, Good Friday, Memorial Day, 1 day in summer for a staff retreat, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and the day after, Christmas Eve, Christmas Day and New Year's Eve.

Ages Served—2.5—5 years

Fees: A yearly \$75 non-refundable registration fee per family is due at the time of registration (1 for any and all programs used).

Tuition rates:

Per hour or any part of an hour
\$5.50 for first child 3-5 yrs
\$5.75 for first child 2.5-3 yrs or not potty trained
\$5.00 for second child
\$4.75 for third child
\$215 a week full-time 3-5 yrs
\$225 a week full-time 2.5-3 yrs (40 or more hours per week)

Money earned through the SCRIP program can be used to offset the weekly cost of extended care.

Payment:

This is a pre-pay program. Tuition is due the first day of attendance for the week.

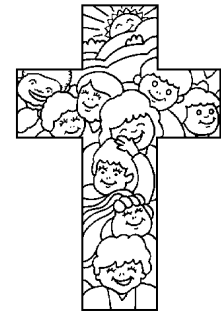
