During our Spring theme, the children learned about birds and flowers. Along with a variety of books and art projects, the children were able to play with bird sees and pretend to plant flowers in our sensory table. Our Jesus' time was spent talking about the crucifixion. The children learned about sins and how Jesus died to take away those sins.

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
